Session One

Brainstorming session asking questions such as:

What is Shropshire? When you talk about Shropshire, what do you think about?

What landmarks do we know in Shropshire?

What do you like the most about Shropshire?

Where do you like to visit most?

Is there a site or location nearby where the children could go to get inspiration - local park, statue, landmark etc? Encourage outside sketching/photography to take inspiration back into the classroom.

Encourage children (age group dependant) to create a mind map of ideas - places, memories, people who are important to them, experiences, iconic representations of Shropshire.

Ask children to talk about their mindmap/favourite idea of what they would like to draw or paint.

Could the children use different tools or techniques to create their picture - collage, paint, pastels, charcoal, dried flowers/leaves, use alternative tools to mark-make with - twigs, feathers, forks, cotton reels, toy cars etc.

Session two

Use the printable template to create an initial composition and discuss how it works - is it balanced, what is the focal point, how could they improve it, add to it, take elements away?

The children will apply their ideas to the final postcard using the composition, tools and materials discussed in the previous lesson.

Encouarge the children to think about an interesting/thought-provoking title for their artwork that will help viewers understand what their artwork means to them.
